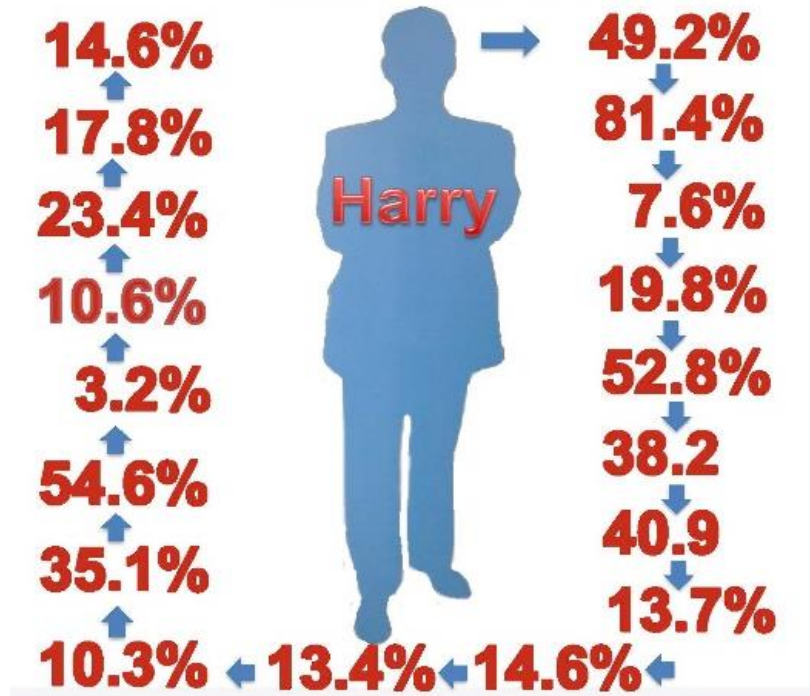


HARRY



- Harry makes up 49.2% of Lehigh Valley’s population
- Harry is 81.4% White, 7.6% African American and 19.8% Hispanic
- Harry makes up 52.8% of the labor force in the Lehigh Valley
- His median age in Lehigh County is 38.2 and 40.9 in Northampton County
- 13.7% of Harry’s are in the 50 to 59 age range, however the largest cohort for Harry’s in the Lehigh Valley is 10-19 age range with 14.6%
- 13.4% are Veterans
- 10.3% of Harry’s 25 years and older have less than a High School education
- 35.1% have a High School diploma or equivalent
- 54.6% have at least some college experience or a higher degree
- Harry’s population grew by 3.2% from 2012 to 2017
- 10.6% of Harry’s were determined to be at poverty or below in the last 12 months
- The largest occupational group Harry belongs to is with production, transportation, and material moving occupations at 23.4%
- The next largest is sales and office occupations at 17.8%, followed by management, business, and financial occupations at 14.6%.

MARY



- Mary makes up 50.8% of Lehigh Valley's population
- Mary is 83.1% White, 6.2% African American, and 19.1% Hispanic
- Mary makes up 47.2% of the labor force in the Lehigh Valley
- Her median age in Lehigh County is 40.7 and 44.1 in Northampton County
- 14.0% of Mary's are in the 50 - 59 range which is also the largest population cohort for Mary's in the Lehigh Valley
- 0.7% are Veterans
- 10.9% of Mary's have less than a High School education
- 32.5% have a High School diploma or equivalent
- 56.5% have at least some college experience or a higher degree
- Mary's population grew by 1.4% from 2012 to 2017
- 12.6% of Mary's were determined to be at poverty level or below in the 12 months
- The largest occupational group Mary belongs to is with sales and office occupations at 31.7%
- The next largest is management, business and financial at 13.2%, followed by education, legal, community service, arts and media occupations at 12.6%.
